

Interested in Joining NEMWA?

Thank you for your interest in joining NEMWA, I have come up with some of the important information that you will need to know about how you go about joining NEMWA. At the end, you will find my email if you have any further questions.

1. You must sign up as a club, **no single** enrollments are allowed. Club dues are \$50.00 for the year. These are made payable to NEMWA and mailed to the NEMWA treasurer, Gary Collins, 2878 N. Ferris Rd., Sumner, MI 48889
2. There is paperwork that must be turned in. This information is mailed to the NEMWA secretary, Dottie Brugger at 2672 W. Coleman Rd, Farwell, MI 48622. The paperwork that is to be mailed is as follows:
 - NEMWA's Player's Agreement or NEMWA Waiver, (gotten off the NEMWA home page way at the bottom www.nemwa.org) this is to be filled out 1 per wrestler. Please make sure that this is filled out correctly and is able to be read by the NEMWA secretary.
 - Birth Certificates, there needs to be on file with the NEMWA secretary a copy of each wrestlers Birth certificate each year. At the NEMWA finals you will be given these back for the following year.
 - AAU, each wrestler and coach is to be a AAU member. This is done online at www.aausports.org. There is a NEMWA club name and code that is to be used. However, if you are already a member of AAU under another wrestling club, I will need a copy of that card. If you are signing up under NEMWA contact the NEMWA secretary and she will email the club name and code to you. You can enter your entire club at one time, and AAU will send you a receipt when you are all done with a list of people who you just done plus your AAU cards, forward your list onto the NEMWA secretary. You will need a credit card for AAU online.
 - NO Player's agreement, birth certificate or AAU, NO wrestling until turned in... All three items **must be** on file before a wrestler is able to wrestle at ANY NEMWA tournament.
3. NEMWA paperwork deadline. There is a deadline that paperwork is to be turned in to be able to wrestle each week. This can be found at www.nemwa.org The first date is December 15, 2011. Then follow the chart on the web site.
4. NEMWA holds 1 kickoff tournament, 6 regular tournaments, regional's and finals. To be able to wrestle in regional's, you must wrestle in 2 regular tournament throughout the 6 weeks. To qualify for finals, you must place in the top 4 at regional's. We are split up into 4 divisions and you will be placed into a division, each week 2 divisions will meet to compete. You must attend the tournament within your division. The NEMWA secretary will keep track of tournaments attended by each wrestler and will let you know if you are able to wrestle.
